

Northeastern Pennsylvania Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Annual Listing of Obligated Projects FFY 2018

INTRODUCTION

The Northeastern Pennsylvania Alliance (NEPA), in conjunction with the Northeastern Pennsylvania Metropolitan Planning Organization (NEPA MPO) Technical Planning Committee and Policy Board, has developed its annual listing of obligated projects for Federal Fiscal Year 2018.

BACKGROUND

The Northeastern Pennsylvania Alliance (NEPA), as a Local Development District (LDD), encompasses all of Carbon, Lackawanna, Luzerne, Monroe, Pike, Schuylkill, and Wayne Counties. NEPA is also designated as a Metropolitan Planning Organization serving as the coordinating agency for transportation planning and programming in Carbon, Monroe, Pike, and Schuylkill counties. Since 1991, the Alliance has had an annual work program with PennDOT. This work program requires that NEPA convene a transportation planning committee on a regular basis.

Following the 2010 Census, an urbanized area was identified in the Stroudsburg area of Monroe County requiring NEPA's transition from a rural planning organization to a metropolitan planning organization. In 2013, the Northeastern Pennsylvania Metropolitan Planning Organization (NEPA MPO) was established, consisting of Carbon, Monroe, Pike and Schuylkill Counties. Two committees were created to guide the NEPA MPO- the NEPA MPO Technical Planning Committee and NEPA MPO Policy Board.

The NEPA MPO Technical Planning Committee is comprised of sixteen (16) voting members that include two (2) representatives from each of the four MPO counties, three (3) transit representatives, a representative from the Urbanized Area, the planning and programming engineer from PennDOT Districts 4-0 and 5-0, a PennDOT Central Office representative, and a representative from NEPA. The NEPA MPO Policy Board is comprised of 5 voting members that include one representative from each of the four MPO counties, appointed by the NEPA Alliance Board of Directors and a transportation professional from PennDOT Central Office. The NEPA MPO Technical Planning Committee and NEPA MPO Policy Board are guided by Operational Procedures, which were adopted in October 2013.

TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

The NEPA MPO Technical Planning Committee and NEPA MPO Policy Board review the area's Transportation Improvement Program (TIP), which is the primary funding source for the counties' highway and bridge projects, and transit system improvements. Through the TIP, transportation projects are identified and advanced to provide for the restoration and development of a multi-



modal transportation infrastructure, which supports economic development by creating a safer and more efficient travel environment for the movement of people and goods. The TIP covers a four-year period of investment, must be fiscally-constrained, and is updated every two years through a cooperative effort of local, state and federal agencies, including participation by the general public. The TIP shows the estimated cost of each project and a projected schedule for completion of the project.

Federal Fiscal Year 2018 Projects were funded through the 2017-2020 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) for the NEPA MPO Region. The 2017-2020 TIP was approved on June 21, 2016, following a 30-day public comment period which included a public hearing.

PURPOSE OF THIS REPORT

The Annual Listing of Obligated Projects is required by the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act. The FAST Act requires metropolitan planning organizations (MPOs) to publish a list of projects for which federal funds have been obligated in the previous year. The federal transportation planning statute states:

- (a) In metropolitan planning areas, on an annual basis, no later than 90 calendar days following the end of the program year, the <u>State</u>, public transportation operator(s), and the MPO shall cooperatively develop a listing of projects (including investments in pedestrian walkways and bicycle transportation facilities) for which funds under <u>23 U.S.C.</u> or 49 U.S.C. Chapter 53 were obligated in the preceding program year.
- (b) The listing shall be prepared in accordance with § 450.314(a) and shall include all federally funded projects authorized or revised to increase obligations in the preceding program year, and shall at a minimum include the TIP information under § 450.326(g)(1) and (4) and identify, for each project, the amount of Federal funds requested in the TIP, the Federal funding that was obligated during the preceding year, and the Federal funding remaining and available for subsequent years.
- (c) The listing shall be published or otherwise made available in accordance with the MPO's public participation criteria for the TIP.

The Federal Highway Administration defines obligation as the federal government's legal commitment (promise) to pay or reimburse states or other entities for the federal share of a project's eligible costs. Thus, an obligated project is one that has been approved by the federal government for reimbursement, though not necessarily reimbursed yet. Obligated projects were not necessarily initiated or completed during this year. The obligated project cost reflected in this report also may not equal final project cost.

HOW TO READ THIS REPORT

The following are the headings in the report:



MPMS- this is the project identification number in the Multimodal Project Management System (MPMS)

SHORT TITLE- this is the name of the project in MPMS.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION- this is a short description of the scope of the project.

PH.- this is the phase of the project. See Project Phase Table for more information.

DIST.- this is the PennDOT District the project is located in.

COUNTY- this is the county the project is located in.

SR- this is the State Route Number for the project.

OBLIG.- this is the federal funds obligated during the time period of the report.

ST. MATCH- this is the state funds for the project.

PROG. TOTAL- This is the total dollars programmed for the project during the four-year TIP.

FUND CLASS- This is the type of funding programmed for the project. See the Funding Code Table for more information.

CCA- Consolidated Capital Agreement.

FPN- Federal Project Number.

PO#- Purchase Order Number.



FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2018 LIST OF OBLIGATED PROJECTS

This report responds to the requirements of the statute. It lists the federally-funded projects in the NEPA MPO region that were obligated in federal fiscal year 2018 (October 1, 2017 to September 30, 2018). Funding can also be "de-obligated" from projects in response to lower than expected costs, project cancellation, or other factors, and these de-obligated funds are often redirected to other projects. Funding for projects that were de-obligated during the fiscal year is noted in the spreadsheet in red.

A summary of federal funds obligated in federal fiscal year 2018 is included on the next page. (Please note that federal transit funds are not included in this summary.)
